Moises" Issues - Density housing needs to be focused in downtown. Where density is already part of the area. Parking has been a priority and he feels sometimes more than people.

Unhoused is an issue. He lives downtown so sees it first hand. Housing cost for single person is 60% of minimum wage job. Transportation is another issue. he believes in Housing first so the unhoused can get the serves they need. His says that if they are in one place than that stability helps. Lack of affordable housing is a big issue.

Drug and mental illnesses are exacerbated by homelessness not the cause.
