Downtown Forward Plan -

Focusing on placemaking and enhanced city services with block by block, downtown main street, traffic control

Make Downtown Safe - police overtime; seeing numbers go down; new substation on central; lights in alleyways; grants to private businesses to put cabq security cameras on their businesses

Extend compassion and assistance - gateway center on Gibson;

Give people something to do - storefront grant program; cultural services; art on rail trail

Build more housing - deficit is 5000 units (need both affordable and market)

Anchor, connect, catalyze - rail yards market improvements; rail trail; innovate abg;

Invest in climate future - improve bus emissions; tree program

Financial tools and partnership - BID for downtown;
